

RESOLUTION 2016-R-152

CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE SPECIAL RUNOFF CITY ELECTION OF THE CITY OF LAREDO HELD ON SATURDAY, DECEMBER 17, 2016 FOR COUNCIL DISTRICT IV; AND APPROVING THE RESULTS.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 2016-O-105 approved on August 15, 2016, the Council ordered a General Election to be held on November 8, 2016 to elect the following City Officials:

COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR DISTRICTS IV, V, VII, AND VIII

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Resolution 2016-R-143 on November 16, 2016 which canvassed the returns of said General and Special Election and ordered a Special Runoff Election on those respective offices where no candidate received a majority vote and the two candidates receiving the highest and second highest number of votes were successful candidates to participate in a runoff election. The office for the Special Runoff Election was:

COUNCIL MEMBER DISTRICT IV

WHEREAS, the runoff election was held between the two candidates who received the highest and second highest number of votes in said Special Runoff Election, namely Allen Tijerina and Alberto Torres, Jr. for the position of Council Member District IV; and

WHEREAS, said City Council has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including ordering, giving notice, and the election officers holding and making return of said Special Runoff Election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby officially found and determined that said meeting was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given, all in accordance with the Election Code and the resolution calling said Special Runoff Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: The City Council finds and determines that said election was duly called and ordered; that proper notice was duly given; that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election; that said election was duly held; that due returns of the results of said election were made and delivered, all in accordance with the Election Code and the order calling said Special Runoff Election; that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with the law and the Resolution calling said election.


Section 2: The City Council officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at said election, as per attached tabulation returns included in this resolution, for the
