

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Reporting Requirement(s) Not Met for PWS TX2400001

We are required to report the results of monitoring of your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis such as Coliform Monitoring. Results of Coliform Monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. During December 2014, January and February 2015, we did not report documentation in the correct manner for the results of Coliform Monitoring.

Our system failed to notify the Texas Commission Environmental Quality drinking water program as required by December 2014, January and February 2015. Although public health was not impacted since these tests were done and passed, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other actions.

What is being done?

While we did not notify the state as we should have, we have paid a fine to the State, we have better trained personnel to do the reporting in a correct manner and we are providing a public notice to the City of Laredo for citizens to be aware of what happened on December 2014, January and February 2015. We are no longer in violation.
